The program aims to enhance the quality use of medicines and reduce the risk of adverse medicine events.

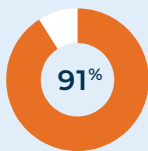


Who is it for?

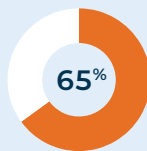
Residents in the following situations may be eligible for a review:

- recently discharged from a hospital,
- significant changes to medication regimen or condition,
- prescribed high-risk medications such as insulin or
- suspected adverse drug reaction or sub-therapeutic response to treatment.
